Preliminary RSA Reporting Information 2017-18

1. When do the preliminary test scores come out?

The grade 3 RSA preliminary reports will be posted to the eMetric Portal on Wednesday July 19, 2017. They will be available at 8:00 a.m. central time. All final reports will be posted to the Portal on October 11, 2017.

2. Is there anything that needs to be checked and verified on the reports?

Yes, check student status codes to make sure any requests made in the testing status application are reflected appropriately. A separate data verification window will be used in late August for data anomalies.

3. Do we need to notify families of these results this summer?

No. However, discussions should occur as soon as possible for students where retention may be appropriate or for those requiring an RSA plan for 4th grade. It is ultimately up to the district to determine the best time to provide these preliminary results to families. As the school year begins shortly, these preliminary RSA results should largely serve to confirm student placement plans made previously by schools and families for the 2017-18 school year. OSDE recommends that districts follow the plan previously determined as most appropriate for each individual student.

4. What does the state want presented to families for Grade 3 RSA as a report from the district?

Districts decide how to best communicate with their families. However, one option may be to print the student view from the [OSTP portal](#).

5. For RSA reporting, how are the performance level categories determined?

This year the reports will indicate the same RSA status as last year Meets Criteria or Does Not Meet Criteria based upon Standard 2.0 and Standard 4.0. The performance levels were determined the same way all state assessment performance levels are determined with Oklahoma state educator input.
