

# Oklahoma Parent Portal Guide

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## PARENT PORTAL OVERVIEW

The Oklahoma Parent Portal is designed to provide students and parents with online access to a student's state assessment scores. This portal will assist a student and his or her parents with tracking assessment information throughout the student's academic career.

The portal provides scores from the OSTP 2016-2017 and 2017-2018 assessments. The OCCT for Grades 3-8, End-of-Instruction (EOI) and the OMAAP scores are not available in the Parent Portal.

The portal will be made up of three basic elements: sign-in page, listing of student's assessments, and a detailed view of the student's results for each assessment.

## SIGN-IN PAGE

Users will access The Oklahoma Parent Portal via a URL provided by eMetric. The sign-in page will be the first page a user will see when visiting the Parent Portal. Access to the portal is provided through the student's state ID and the student's birth date. NOTE: The student's state ID will be unique across the state. It will not change and will be associated with that student throughout the student's academic career. The date of birth used for logging in must match the date of birth on the student's school record

### I. Follow the steps below to log in to the Parent Portal.

1. Enter the URL into a web browser or mobile browser. This will take you to the login page. The following mock up shows the desktop/tablet browser mode.

2. Enter your child's state ID.

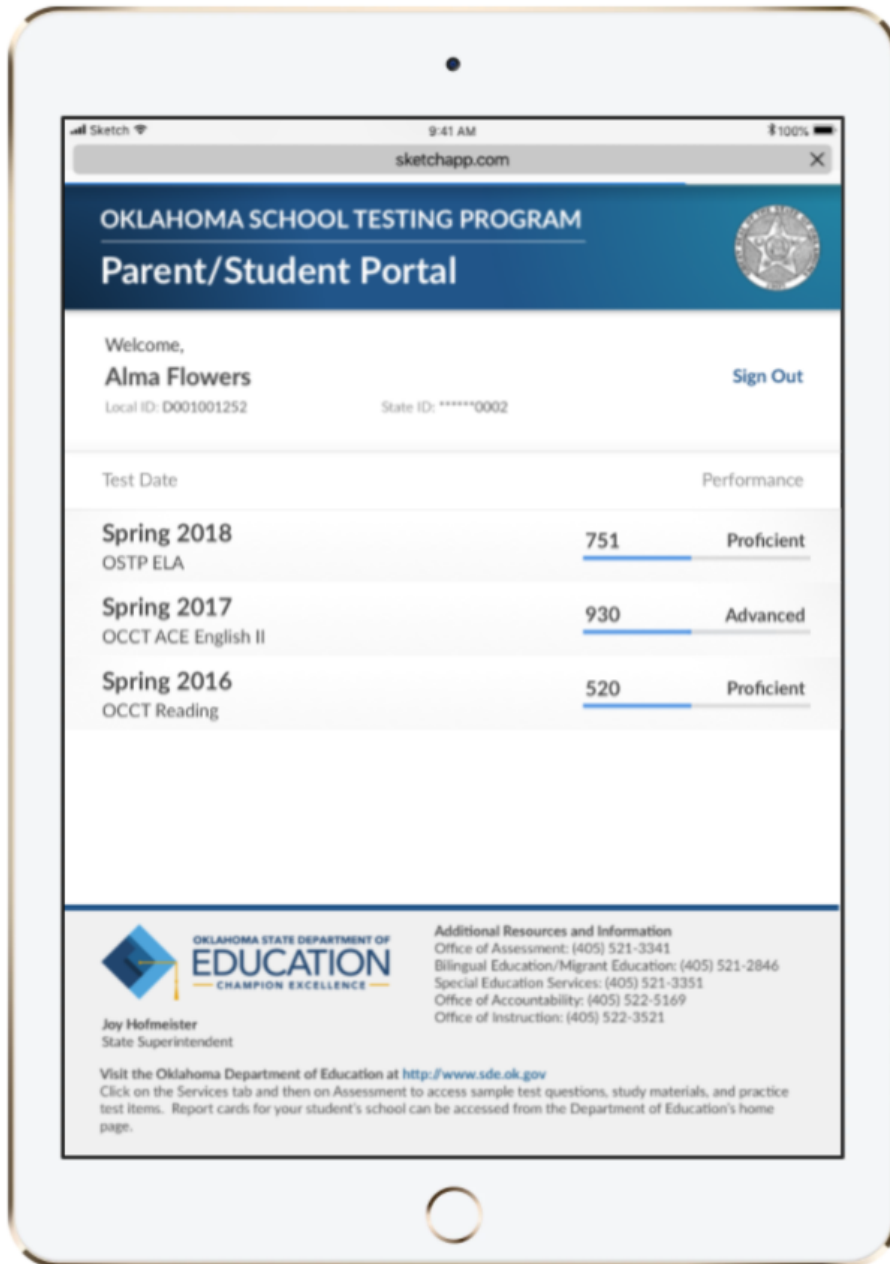
3. Enter your child's data of birth.

4. Click the "Go" button to login.

5. If you do not know your child's state ID, click on "Where's my Student ID?" link

## LISTING PAGE

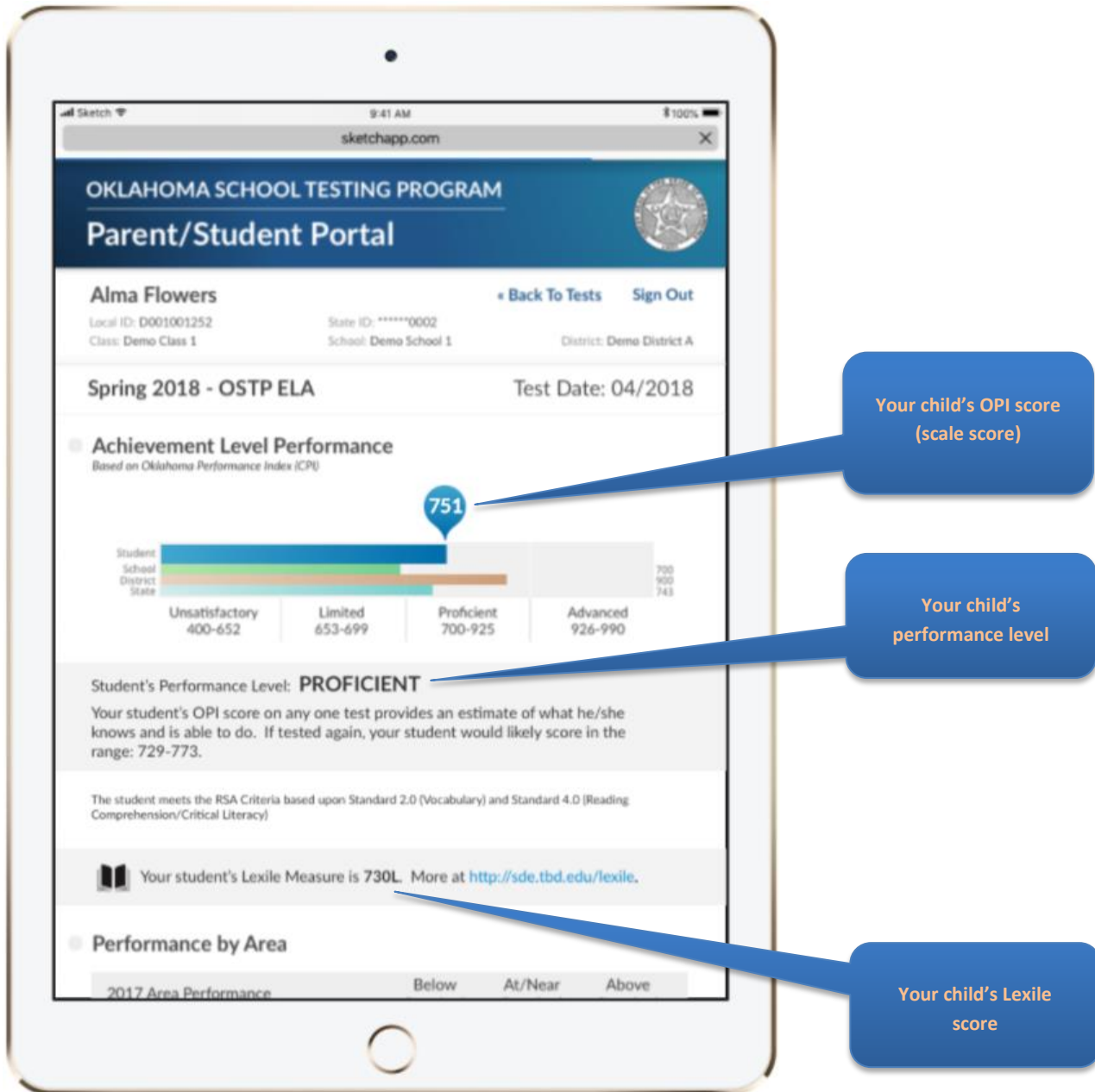
The listing page will be used to display overall results for all of the assessments that a student has been administered and are included in the data delivered to eMetric with a valid student state ID and the student's birth date. For example, a 5<sup>th</sup> grade student who has just completed the 5<sup>th</sup> grade assessment would have a listing for the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> grade assessment results in the respective subjects, assuming the student has a valid state ID and birth date for each record. 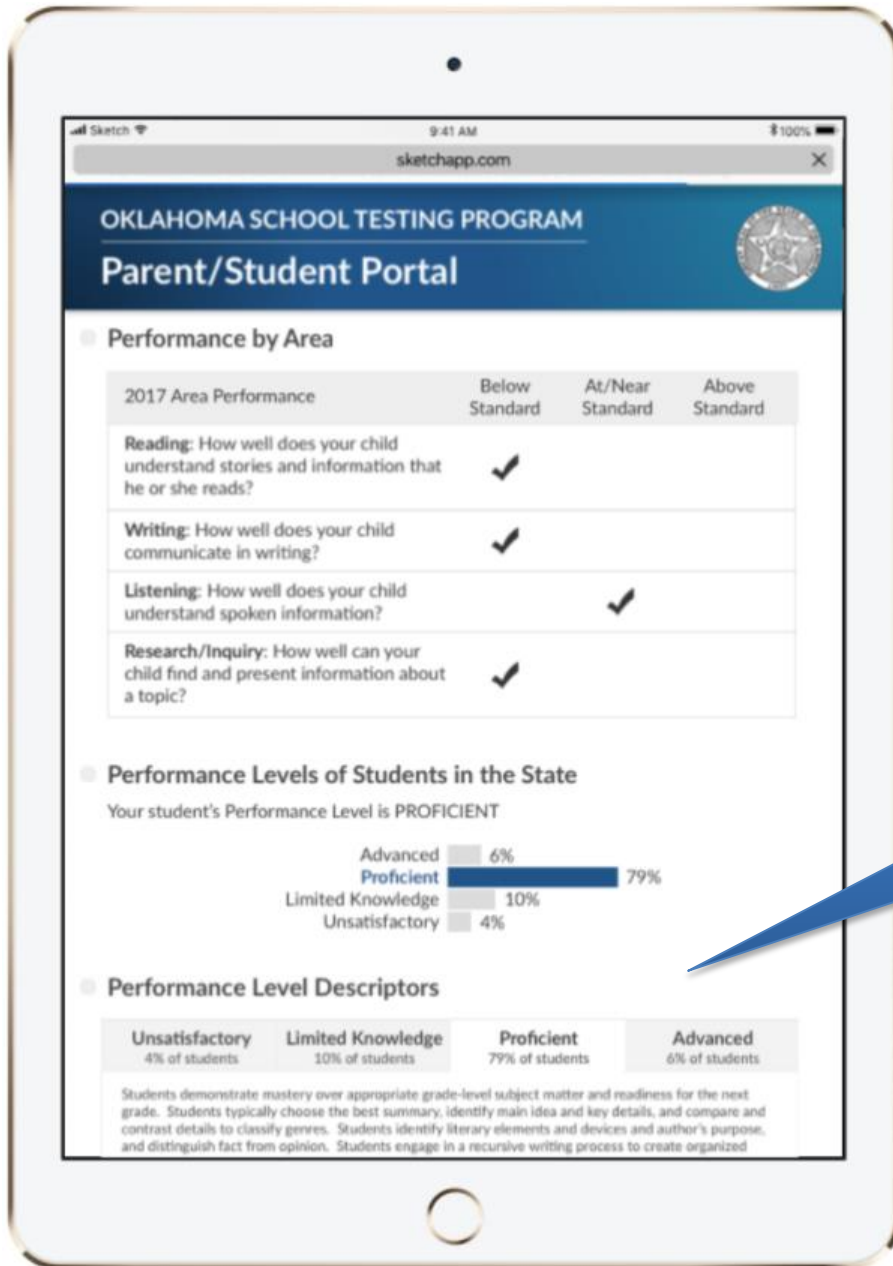

## DETAILED RESULTS PAGE

The detailed results page lists the student's assessment scores for a particular administration and subject. It will display the student's scale scores, performance levels, performance level score ranges, RSA criteria (applicable only for Grade 3 reading), Lexile measure, Quantile measure, student's performance levels in the state etc. Refer to the mock ups below:

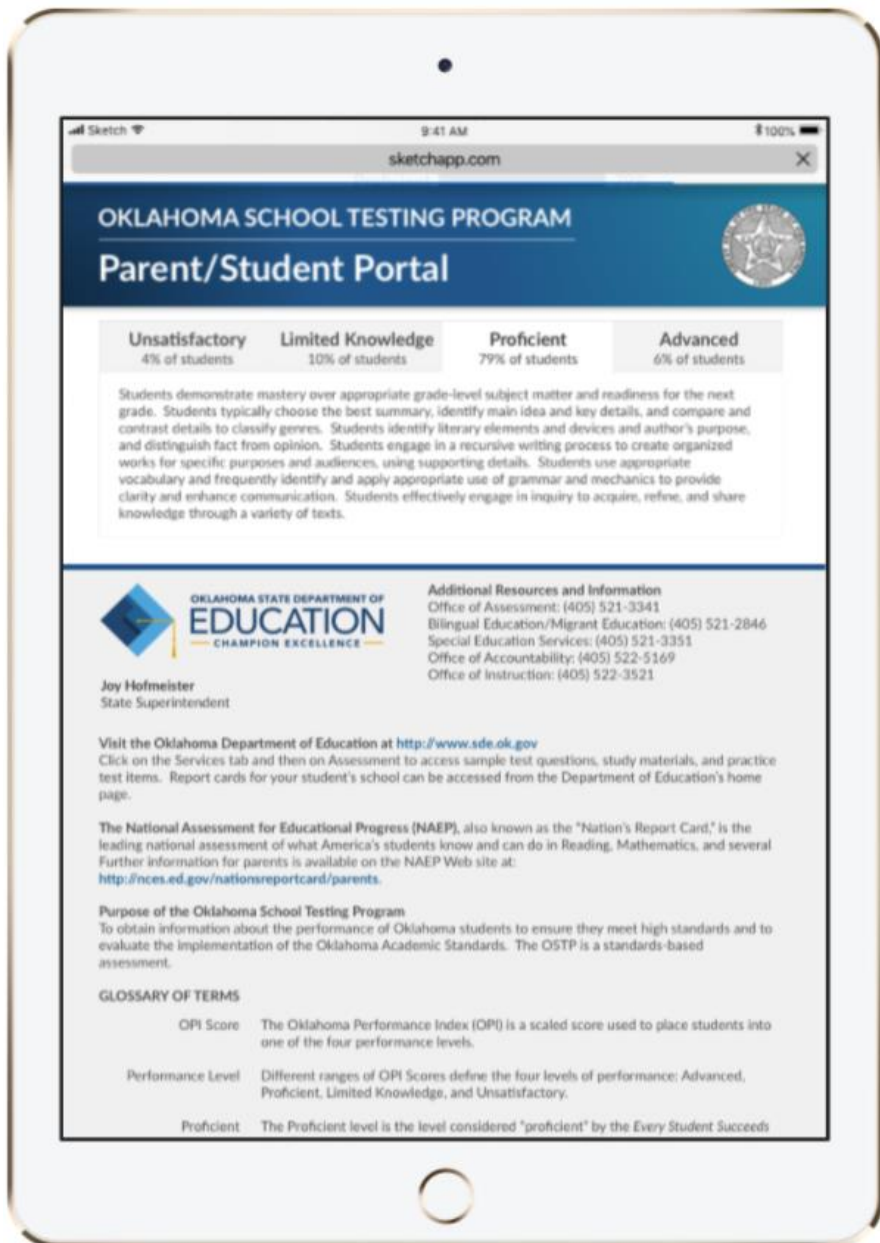


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The percentage of students in each performance level across the state.

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## TRAINING & SUPPORT

The Oklahoma Parent Portal will be available to the users on September 4<sup>th</sup>, 2018. eMetric will provide a WebEx training to Measured Progress and Oklahoma State Department of Education (OK SDE), dates to be decided. eMetric will provide a WebEx training to DTCs and STCs in the last week of August (27<sup>th</sup> – 31<sup>st</sup>), dates to be decided. The DTCs and BTCs can then train the parents.

eMetric will provide a video tutorial of the Parent Portal. The video will be posted to Measured Progress’s Help & Support website. The DTCs and BTCs will download the video from the website and distribute to the parents and students via the school’s internal website.

eMetric will provide technical support to the users until the end of the contract.
